836 – FITNESS CENTER USAGE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday thru Friday4:00 - 8:00 a.m. & 4:00 - 10:00 p.m.

Saturday and Sunday....4:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

ALL HOURS OF OPERATION ARE UNSUPERVISED!

Participants must leave the building by 11:00 p.m.

2. SUPERVISION OF STUDENTS

Students must be supervised at all times. Students must be supervised by school-authorized personnel. Access for students is to be scheduled by school personnel. Schedules are to be made available to the public. Unauthorized use by students will result in a suspension. When supervising students, supervisors must not be using the equipment.

When students are using equipment outside of school hours, they must be supervised by a parent/guardian.

3. AGE

The minimum requirement for access to the Greenwood Community Wellness Center is evidence of entry of the seventh grade year of school.

All graduates of Greenwood High School may use the Greenwood Fitness Center until June 1st of their graduating year. After that time, they may purchase a single membership.

4. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Training on safe use of equipment is required prior to use. All new members will be required to attend an orientation session.
- Drugs, alcohol, steroids and tobacco products are strictly prohibited.
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the fitness center with the exception of bottled water.

- Proper attire is required.
 - a. Tennis shoes for indoor use only are required. Tennis shoes used in the Fitness Center should never be worn outside.
 - b. Shirts covering the entire torso are required. Sleeveless shirts are allowed if properly hemmed. No cut off shirts will be allowed.
 - c. Shorts must be worn at waist level. Only athletic shorts are permissible. Cut-offs, cargo shorts, etc. are not acceptable. Sweat pants or pants designed for athletic wear are allowed.
 - d. At no time will undergarments be visible.
 - e. Rules for Greenwood students and the board adopted dress code are applicable at all times. The dress code is available for review in the student handbook.

- Personal music devices are allowed with use of ear buds.
- Music and television volume will be monitored to be considerate of others.
- All equipment must be wiped down with available disinfectant wipes or towels after use. Treadmills must be powered off after use.
- Athletic bags, purses, outerwear and street shoes are not allowed inside the fitness center. Please use the provided space in the lobby.
- All rules of common sense and appropriate behavior are expected at all times concerning horseplay, cursing, spitting, etc.
- Proper use of all equipment is mandatory at all times.
- Any deviation of expected behavior and rules should be reported and will result in the suspension of the use.
- No pets allowed.

836.1 – FITNESS CENTER – USAGE FEE STRUCTURE

The Greenwood Fitness Center is available for students, staff and residents of the Greenwood School District. Out of district staff members are eligible for individual and family memberships that include their spouses. Parents of open-enrolled students are also eligible for membership to the Greenwood Fitness Center.

IN-DISTRICT ANNUAL FEE STRUCTURE:

Annual Fee applies for one year. Applicable to staff (and spouses), district residents, taxpayers within the district and parents of open enrolled students:

One-Month Trial	\$10.00	<i>(This fee can be applied to an annual membership.)</i>
Individual	\$50.00	
Family	\$90.00	
Individual - Senior Citizen*	\$25.00	
Family - Senior Citizen*	\$40.00	

***Senior Citizen rates apply to age 60 and older.**

GUESTS:

Non-residents must be accompanied by a community member and registered as a guest. All guests must register and sign appropriate waivers and agreements. **Guests will be charged a daily fee of \$5.00.**

KEY FOBs:

Key Fobs will be assigned to individuals and families of registered users. We ask that each person swipe their card individually to monitor the overall usage of the facility. The fee will be returned to the user once the key is returned. Users are not permitted to lend their key out to anyone. Unauthorized use of key fobs will result in the loss of use of facilities.

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KEY FOB REPLACEMENT FEE:

If at any time you lose or damage your key fob, you will need a replacement. Users are responsible for the cost of replacement.

836.2 – FITNESS CENTER MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

GOVERNANCE:

The School District of Greenwood has the sole power to amend, supplement, or modify, without notice, the Rules and Regulations of the Greenwood Fitness Center. Member(s) understand that this membership is subject to those rules and regulations that are in effect and amended as deemed necessary. The member(s) acknowledges receipt of a copy of this agreement and the written rules and regulations of the facility. Violations of these rules and regulations can result in loss of membership with no right to any refund of membership fee.

In order to assure safety and enjoyment of all members, the School District of Greenwood reserves the right to cancel membership of any member whose action is detrimental to the enjoyment or safety of fellow members. The Fitness center is under 24 hour surveillance. If it is determined that action must be taken, there will be no recourse for appeal or refund.

The School District of Greenwood will continue to monitor and review the rules and regulations regarding the use of the Fitness Center and adapt them to best provide for the safety and enjoyment of all members. Notice of any changes will be posted for members to review.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Hours of operation are to be designated by the School District of Greenwood Board of Education. Hours of operation will be posted. Although the district will attempt to provide consistent hours available to the public, hours of operation may be subject to change. All attempts to provide up-to-date availability will be made. During student-designated hours, students will have priority on the available equipment.

ENTRY:

All members are to use the east entrance door # 9, designated entry to the fitness center. Entry to the Greenwood Fitness Center will require usage of a key fob. Each member will receive a key fob and each member must enter individually. Any misuse of entry provisions will result in immediate termination of membership with no refunds. Unauthorized entrance of the Fitness Center by non-members is not permitted. Loss or damage of the key fob will result in a \$10 replacement fee.

GUESTS:

Guests may be allowed to enter the fitness center (one guest per member). Member is responsible for placing a \$5.00 guest fee in the appropriate drop box. Each guest is to sign the guest waiver form. Abuse of the guest privilege will result in immediate termination of membership with no refund.

VIOLATIONS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Each member will be given a copy of the rules and regulations. In the event the member violates any of the rules and regulations herein contained or posted in the fitness center or as amended, the School District of Greenwood may terminate the membership with no refund. The initials below indicate that member has received a copy of the rules and regulations, understands the established rules and regulations and agrees to adhere to them.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK OF INJURY:

Members understand that by signing this agreement, they assume all risk of injury and waive all rights to pursue personal damages of any kind when in and using the equipment provide in the Greenwood Fitness Center. In the event an injury should take place on the School District of Greenwood property, member shall hold harmless the School District of Greenwood, employee's and agents of all liability claims, including claims for contribution. This waiver of liability shall apply to their heirs and assign.

MEMBER INDEMNIFICATION:

Members understand and agree that the Fitness Center will be unsupervised. Member acknowledges that no employee will be on site to provide assistance in using the equipment, member assumes all risk. In recognition of the possible danger connected with any physical activity, member hereby knowingly and voluntarily waives any right of cause of action now or hereafter of any kind whatsoever arising from which any liability, which may or could accrue to the School District of Greenwood. Member will reimburse the School District of Greenwood for any damages he/she may cause to the equipment and/or to the physical infrastructure of the facility.
